

## 2011 Enrollment Trends Overview

### TOTAL ENROLLMENT (Fig. 1)

- **Total Enrollment in 2011: 942 Students**
- Enrollment grew by 2.4% (22 students) from 2010 to 2011.

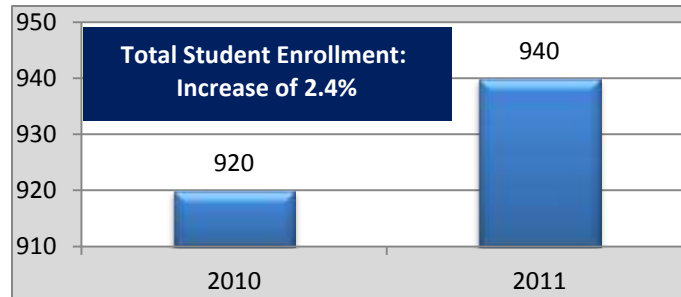

### GENDER (Fig. 2)

- **The 2011 male population stands at 522 students (55.5%).**
- **The 2011 female population stands at 420 students (44.5%).**

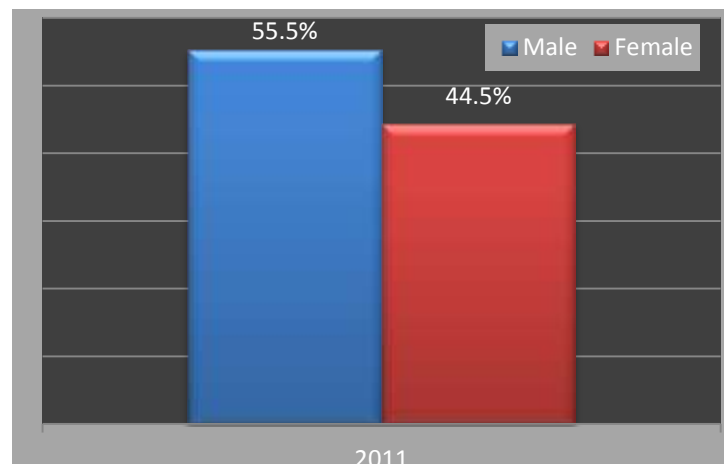

### MINORITY (Fig. 3)

- **The 2011 minority student population stands at 258 students (27.5%).**
- The number of minority students (and corresponding percentage of the total student body) has continued to increase over the past several years:
  - 2010: 234 minority students (25.4%)
  - 2009: 193 minority students (22.9%)
  - 2008: 185 minority students (22.6%)

- **The 2011 Hispanic /Latino student population stands at 112 students (11.8%).**
- The Hispanic/Latino population has seen a steady increase over the past several years:
  - 2010: 89 H/L students
  - 2009: 89 H/L students
  - 2008: 83 H/L students
  - 2007: 74 H/L students
  
- **The 2011 Asian student population stands at 78 (8.3%).**
- The Asian population has seen increases over the past several years:
  - 2010 and 2009: 65 Asian students
  - 2008: 63 Asian students
  - 2007: 52 Asian students
  
- **The 2011 African American student population stands at 35 (3.7%).**
- The African American population has seen increases over the past years (exception in 2008):
  - 2010: 28 African American students
  - 2009: 20 African American students
  - 2008: 37 African American students

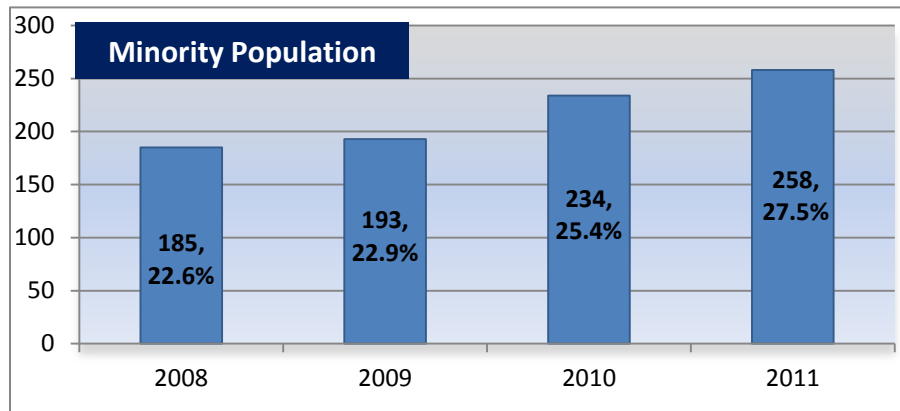

**AGE (Fig. 4)**

- **The 2011 traditional student population (aged 23 and below) stands at 758 students (80.5%).**
- **The 2011 non-traditional student population (aged 24+) stands at 184 students (19.5%).**
  - The enrollment of nontraditional students grew by 26 students from 2010 to 2011.

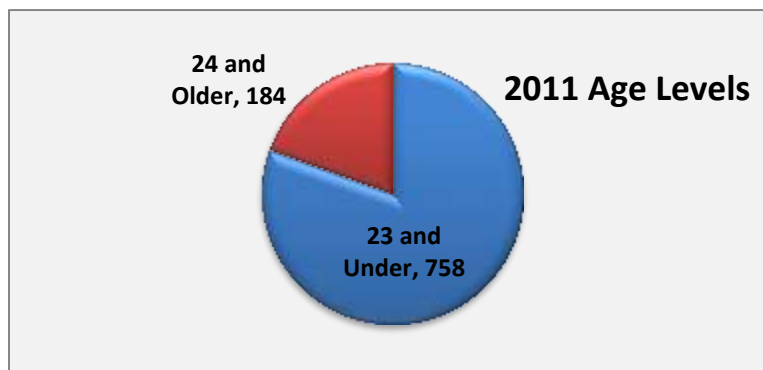

**RESIDENCY (Fig. 5)**

- **The 2011 PA-Resident population stands at 900 (95.5%).**
- **The 2011 Non-PA Resident population stands at 42 (4.5%).**
  - Other residencies include NJ (11), NY (6), Foreign (4), CA (2), DE (1), MA (1), MD (1), TX (1), FL (1), Armed Forces (1), missing information (13)

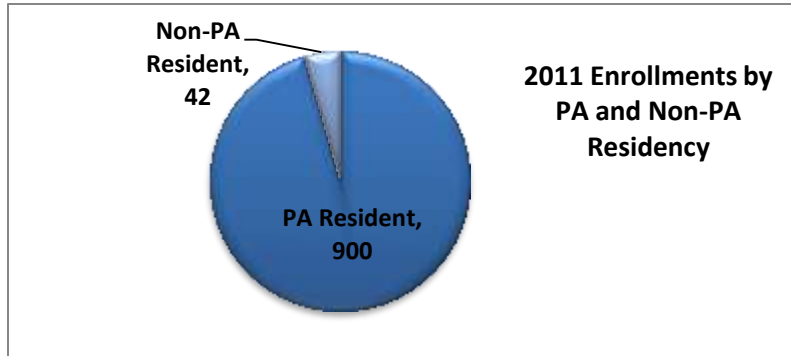

- **The 2011 undergraduate population stands at 914 (97%).**
- **The 2011 graduate population stands at 27 students (3%).**

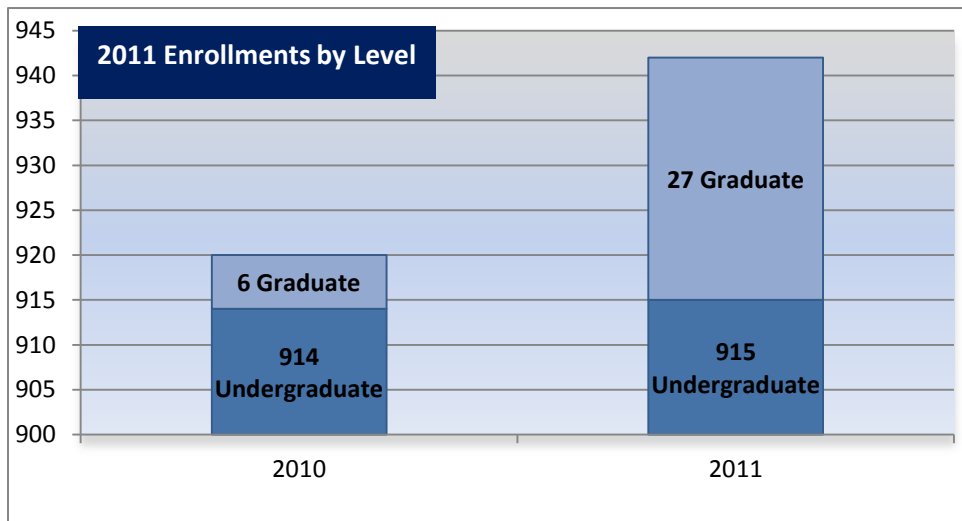
